3. We will have an Instagram page (it has been created in the meantime → RES.rotaryeuropeanstars) as the meeting point for the Alumni and as the mean of communication on social networks for the RES project.
4. Maria, Jean Marc and Alexander are going to prepare the new manifesto to start the recruiting of the 30 people for next year meeting in Stuttgart. The goal is to have the document ready for the end of the year. It will be published on a specific web page of the RY-core website and on Instagram. It will also be spread to all the clubs in the CORE area
